

WESTSIDE WATERLOO TRAILS

Trail length: 4.3 kilometres

Westside Waterloo includes one of the largest remaining woodlands within the City. Known as Forested Hills, this “Environmentally Sensitive” woodland contains significant wetlands, rare plants, migratory breeding birds and a variety of wildlife. Eventually a fifty-two kilometre network of trails will connect Forested Hills, Clair Woods and Activa Woods to parks, shopping and neighbourhoods. Watch for interpretive signs along the trail.

LAUREL CREEK CONSERVATION AREA

Trail length: 1 kilometre

Covering 294 hectares (725 acres), the Laurel Creek Conservation Area is owned and managed by the Grand River Conservation Authority. A beautiful natural setting complete with a lake, it is open from May 1st to October 15th. Enjoy swimming, windsurfing and hiking during the summer months and, in winter, there are eight kilometres of groomed and track set cross-country ski trails to enjoy.

An entrance fee applies.
